

## How do I extend a running Timer?

*Note: If you set a timer or start and instant record and realise the timer will finish before the program finishes, you can extend the timer. This can happen if there is a news flash or if the previous program over runs.*

*This tutorial assumes you have a timer already in progress.*

1. Press the **POP-UP** button on the remote and use the **ARROW** keys on the remote to select **Recording Information** and press **OK**.



2. Use the **ARROW** keys to highlight the running timer you want to extend.



3. Use the **ARROW** keys to increase / decrease the **Duration**.
4. Press the **EXIT** button on the remote to resume normal viewing.



*Note: You can **Stop** a running timer by highlighting the recording with the **ARROW** keys and pressing the **STOP** button. You can also **Change** the **File Name** by highlighting the running timer with the **ARROW** keys and pressing the **RED** button. This will open the **Keyboard Input** dialog – allowing you to change the **File Name**.*
